Literacy



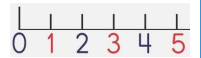

We will be providing lots of reading opportunities both within lessons and our classroom environment.

Foundation Stage 2 Oak and Willow Class

Learning together at home:

We are aiming to support all children in writing their own name this term. Supporting your children in using a pencil and recognising their names would be very helpful. Playdough or playing with pasta at home can greatly support children's hand control if they are finding holding a pencil tricky. We will also focus on all aspects of numbers one to five, see if you can spot them out and about when in the car/walking to school.

Numeracy



We have started by singing number songs on the carpet. We will continue to build our knowledge by focusing on one number per week, building up to number 5 by half term. We will use lots of physical resources to support the children in knowing their numbers securely.
