We will be learning to:

- Move in different speeds... slow and fast.

- Traffic light game. Listening to and following instructions. Move skilfully and negotiate space. Adjusting speed or direction.



Communication and Language

We will be singing nursery rhymes and reading stories together daily.

- Continue to use our developing language to share our feelings, experiences and thoughts.
- Use our developing language to connect ideas, link language to describe our experiences.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be learning to:

- Continue to support the children to recognise and understand the rules for being together with others, such as waiting for a turn.
- Talk about feelings such as sadness, happiness, or feeling cross.
- Continue to understand and cooperate with the class boundaries and routines.

We will continue to learn to recognise our name and practise some of the letter shapes, using our name cards and whiteboards to help us.

Listens to stories with increasing attention and recall. Begins to describe main story settings and characters.

Understanding the World

We will be learning to:

- Play with small world-world models, such as cars, a garage or train track.
- Tell stories about transport and journeys. How do we get to school... 'walk', 'bus', 'car'?
- Explore and talk about our environment. Ask questions comment on what we see.

Numeracy

We will be learning to:

- Use different sizes and shapes of containers in sand/water play, allowing the children to experiment with quantities and measures.
- Concept Cat. Introduce prepositions: 'in', 'out', 'under', 'behind', 'top', 'bottom'.
- Continue with singing counting songs and rhymes, developing children's understanding of number.
