

## Physical Development

P.E will be on;

Friday am for NAM and Monday pm for NPM.

We will be learning to:

- Move like animals. . by performing simple movements e.g. crawl, jump, slither. Encourage activities such as stretching, reaching, curling, twisting and turning.
- Animal movements.

## Communication and Language

We will be singing nursery rhymes and reading stories together daily.

- We will listen out for sounds around us and talk about the sounds that we hear.
- Continue to use our developing language to share our feelings, experiences and thoughts.
  - Use language linked to movement. . . slow/quick/strong/gentle/heavy/stretch/reach/tense/floppy.

We will be learning to:

- Continue to support the children to recognise and understand the rules for being together with others, such as waiting for a turn.
- Talk about feelings such as sadness, happiness, or feeling cross.
- Continue to understand and cooperate with the class boundaries and routines.

### Writing:

### Phonics – Phase 1
