This school deals effectively with bullying 89\%. Although this is the lowest percentage, $90 \%$ agreed/ agreed strongly with only 1 parent disagreeing and $10 \%$ stating they did not know. This is on the Behaviour Action Plan to raise parent awareness with regards to how we tackle bullying.
$100 \%$ of the questionnaires that did not report 'agree' or 'strongly agree' ticked 'don't know'. We have introduced Phase Leaders who are now dealing with many issues as we have promoted our middle leadership. Parents have always gone straight to the SLT before, now we have a distributed leadership in which parents/ carers need to understand.

This is the best ever response we have had as a school. The percentages are the best we have had positively in many years also. There are a few pockets where parents disagreed with the highest of 95\% being homework. Parents have been asking for more maths/ English, science, times tables, drawing and comprehensions which were mainly in Years 4,5 and 6 and a couple in Year 3.
