# English

#### We will.

- Work towards mastering Set 1 & 2 phonics.
- Apply phonics and sight words when reading and writing.
- Write simple sentences.
- Use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in our writing.
- Read traditional tales like Goldilocks and the Three Bears and The Three Little Pigs.

### Maths

### We will:

- Count forwards and backwards to IO.
- Show amounts in different representations.
- Order numbers to IO.
- Make number bonds to 10.
- Compare numbers within 10.
- Begin to solve simple addition and subtraction.

# Computing

We will be learning about how technology is used in our school and how to stay safe online.

## Science

We will be learning about the human body and naming main body parts and our senses.

#### **PSHE**

In PSHE we will be thinking about our rights and responsibilities and how different types of behaviour can make others feel.

We will also learn more about eating healthily.

### Art
