English

We will be learning to:

- Work towards mastering Set 3 phonics.
- Apply phonics and sight words when reading and writing.

Reading

We shall continue to teach reading with the whole class. We

will examine a variety of texts and retrieve information from

them. We will work on building our fluency so we are having

to sound out fewer words. Children must continue to read every day at home and school.

If a child learns to read, they will have the keys to learn!

Geography

We will be looking at the United Kingdom and locating the

different countries. We will look at hot and cold countries

and what we might need in both types of country.

- Use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in our writing.
- Explore stories and write narratives.
- Create a leaflet.
- Write a weather report.

We will be creating a weather report with a green screen and visit Braunstone Park.

Maths

We will be learning to:

- Multiply and divide—using equal groups
- Find simple fractions
- Know place value of numbers within 100
- Tell the time to o'clock and half past
- Describe position and direction

PSHF

In PSHE we will be thinking about living in the wider world. We will also learn about online safety (how we can keep safe online) and how we can create and keep respectful relationships.

Science

We will be learning about the different weather and how these change depending the seasons. We will be looking at weather types in the UK and compare these to India.

RE

We will be learning about Christianity and visiting the local church to explore a place of worship.

Computing and Art

We will continue to take part in a whole trust project with specialist Computing and Art teachers. In computing we will learn about simple programming and in art we will build our different art skills to then create a final outcome
