English

This term in English, we will be writing our own myths and legends, developing our use of grammar with direct speech and fronted adverbials.

We will then move on to a character description applying all the writing skills we have learnt, writing about a character that is prevalent in Greek mythology. Finally, we will write about what we have learnt from Ancient Greece today in a non-chronological report.

Maths

This term in maths, we shall be continuing our work on multiplication and division, consolidating our 3, 4, 6 and 8 times tables

We shall also be exploring fractions, time, properties of shape and mass and capacity.

Please continue to practice on Times Table Rockstars every day to develop your fluency.

Geography

We shall be learning about the human and physical features of the world, specifically looking at Greece ad comparing the similarities and differences to the United Kingdom. We will also be developing our locational knowledge using atlases and maps to locate the world's countries.

Our Topic: Ancient Greece!



History

We will be looking at Ancient Greek life. We will use a timeline to help us understand the order events have happened in. We will be considering their achievements and the influence this has on our lives today.

Religious Education

We will be exploring Sikhism and the key beliefs and festivals of the religion.

PSHF

We will be exploring how to live in the wider world, how to form and maintain respectful relationships and the changes in our bodies.

Computing and Music

We shall be taking part in a whole trust project with a specialist computing teacher. We will be introduced to learning how to play samba music, exploring different percussion instruments.

Reading

We shall continue teaching reading with the whole class. We will examine a variety of texts and retrieve information from them, as well as developing our inference skills and widening our understanding of different vocabulary.

Children must continue to read every day; don't forget to sign their reading record. Please ensure they bring their levelled reading book to school every day.

We are really excited as the children will be learning Spanish this term; focussing on learning greetings and animals

Science

In Science, we shall be learning about plants. We will be able to identify the parts of a plants and explain their functions. We will be looking at the life cycle of plants and the requirements of plants for life and growth.
