English

We will:

- Work towards mastering Set 2 & 3 phonics.
- Apply phonics and sight words when reading and writing.
- Use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in our writing.
- Explore stories and write narratives.
- Write a fact file
- Write a set of instructions.

We will:

Begin to solve simple addition and subtraction questions within 20.

Maths

- Order numbers to 50.
- Compare numbers within 50.
- Count in 2's, 5's and 10's.
- Learn to measure using standard and non standard units.

Science

We will be learning about materials, plants and the different parts of plants and animals.
