English

In English this term we will be looking at writing a letter, setting description and instructions. We will focus on:

- Talking and writing in full sentences
- Using capital letters and full stops consistently in sentences
- Studying fiction and non-fiction
- Broadening our vocabulary
- Using adjectives, verbs and adverbs
- Question sentences
- Joining letters in Handwriting
- Reading individually and in groups
- Year 2 spelling rules
- Spelling sight words and common exception words

Geography: Location

We will be exploring and learning about:

- Human and physical features of the UK and India.
- Naming the countries of the UK
- Naming & locating the 7 continents and 5 oceans.
- Comparing the UK and India;

Maths

In Math's this term, we are focusing on money, multiplication and division, fractions and shape. We will be learning about:

- Comparing and recognizing coins and notes.
- Adding amounts.
- Finding change.
- Counting & recalling our 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- Grouping and sharing in 2, 5 and 10s.
- Counting in our 3 and 4's.
- Fractions of a shape and a number
- 2D and 3D shapes

Music

We will be learning about making sounds with our voices and exploring with tuned and untuned musical instruments to create our own piece of music.

Art and Computing

We shall be taking part in a whole trust project with a specialist Art and IT Teacher. In computing we will be exploring programming and in art we will build our different art skills to then create a final outcome.
