English

This term in English, we shall be creating a biography on the amazing astronaut Mae Jamison. We shall be learning about passive voice and how authors use this. We shall also be creating a piece of narrative writing based on a fantasy settings. They will also have the opportunity to design their own planet and will write a Non-Chronological

explaining all its geographical features.

The children will continue to develop their grammar knowledge by using Century to support their blended learning.

Maths
