

# Year 3 2022 Spring Curriculum Newsletter









## **English**

This term in English, we will be writing non-fiction text types, writing an explanation text about how a fossils are formed.

We will then move on to write a newspaper report about a volcanic eruption.

Finally, setting descriptions, developing our use of grammar to add detail with similes, prepositional phrases and exclamations.

### Maths

This term in maths, we shall be continuing our work on multiplication and division, consolidating our 3, 4 and 8 times tables

We shall also be exploring measurement (including length and perimeter), mass and capacity and fractions.

Please continue to practice on Times Table Rockstars every day to develop your fluency.

### Geography

We shall be learning about volcanoes and earthquakes. We will investigate how volcanoes erupt and explore some of the world's famous volcanoes, before moving on to learning about earthquakes. We will be using Virtual Reality headsets to deepen our understanding and explore these geographical features.

### Design & Technology

We shall be making pizzas as part of our cooking unit this term. We will develop our safe cutting skills, consider and describe our chosen ingredients and deepen our understanding of the importance of food hygiene.

# Religious Education

We will be exploring the importance of festivals in a range of religions, before focussing on the Easter festival in particular.

### **PSHE**

We will be exploring emotional intelligence, discussing a range of different feelings and ways we can respond

## Art

We shall be taking part in a whole trust project with a specialist Art Teacher. In this block of lessons, we shall explore a range of 3D art media. These will include using Modroc and clay to make sculptures, and explore how to use mixed media for 3D art. We will also develop our sketching skills as we design our sculptures.

### Reading

We shall continue teaching reading with the whole class. We will examine a variety of texts and retrieve information from them, as well as developing our inference skills and widening our understanding of different vocabulary.

Children must continue to read every day; don't forget to sign their reading record. Please ensure they bring their levelled reading book to school every day.

Spanish We are really excited as the children will be learning Spanish this term; focussing on learning colours and numbers.

### Science

In Science, we shall be learning about rocks. We will be looking at fossils, learning about how they form. We will be visiting Lapworth Museum in Birmingham to help us explore the different types of fossils.
