English

In English this term we will be looking at writing a retell, setting description and a recount. We will focus on:

- Talking and writing in full sentences
- Using capital letters and full stops consistently in sentences
- Studying fiction and non-fiction
- Broadening our vocabulary
- Using adjectives, verbs and adverbs
- Question sentences
- Beginning to form letters cursively
- Reading individually and in groups
- Year 2 spelling rules
- Spelling sight words and common exception words

Science

We will be exploring and learning about:

- Animals including humans
- Plants and how they grow
- Life cycles of animals and humans
- Living things and their habitats

Maths

We will be learning about:

- Measurement: Length cm and m; Capacity l and ml; weight using g and kg
- Time—telling the time to half past and o'clock
- Position and Direction
- Revision of the four operations—addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
