English


This term in English, we shall be writing a set of instructions on brushing our teeth, this is linked to the work the children are doing in science and we will be recording a video to show to younger year groups as well. We will also be writing a story opening. The children will be looking at using descriptive language, expanded noun phrases and different sentence starters.

The children will continue to develop their grammar knowledge by using Century as part of their blended learning.

Science

In science we will be learning about the human body. We will look at the digestive system, teeth, the skeleton, and muscles. We will also look at sound and how we hear.

Spanish

We are really excited as the children will be learning Spanish this term; focussing on learning how to introduce themselves and talk about their families.

Maths

This term in maths, we shall be focussed on money and time. The children will look at pounds and pence, ordering money, giving change and working with money. In our unit on time, they will look at telling time up to the minute, 12 and 24 hour clocks, and analogue and digital clocks.

We shall continue with our fluency and speed of timetables by competing on Times Tables Rockstars—**keep practising as much as possible at home too!** If you want to get ahead of the game, and pre-teach yourself. There are lots of available videos on the Whiterose website.

Computing

We shall be taking part in a whole trust project with a specialist IT Teacher. In computing they will be learning about how to edit photos as well as continuing to focus on online safety.

PSHE

We will be focussing on the role of money in our everyday lives, looking at how money is managed. We will also be looking at sustainability from a whole world perspective. We will then look at job and career aspirations.

Reading

We shall continue to teach reading with the whole class. We will examine a variety of texts to expand our vocabulary, retrieve information and develop our inference.
Children must continue to read every day at home as well as in school.

We will be exploring healthy eating and foods and will be making pizzas. The children will be choosing the ingredients to include, using kitchen equipment and making the pizzas.
